WHAT CAN I SELL?

- Any season infant & children's clothing (to size 10), shoes and accessories.
- Any season maternity clothing (less than 5 years old please)
- Dance attire, dress-up clothes, school uniforms and like-new swimwear
- Toys, children's books and DVDs, games and puzzles, pregnancy and parenting books and DVDs
- Baby blankets, crib sheets, bumpers, nursery decorations, diaper bags
- Stuffed Animals that "do" something like move, light up, sing
- Cribs, highchairs, strollers, bath seats, baby swings, outside toys, playpens, exersaucers, etc.
- Outdoor play equipment

PLEASE NOTE that all large equipment must be less than ten years old and in excellent condition.

WHAT CAN I NOT SELL?

- Undergarments
- Stuffed animals
- Car seats
- Torn, stained, or outdated clothing and shoes
- Dirty or broken toys, furniture, and baby equipment

All items will be inspected upon drop-off. Please do not be offended if some items are turned down. Our standards are high.

HOW DO I PREPARE MY ITEMS?

Get your supplies ready! Have the following on hand for fast tagging: safety pins, 3x5 cards, hangers, clear packing tape, scissors, hole punch, Ziploc bags, rubber bands, marker.

- Clean and prepare garments. Clean, pressed items will sell faster.
- Put clothing on a hanger facing left. The hanger will look like a question mark - ?.
- Pants and swimsuits must be safety-pinned to the hanger.
- Toys, games, cribs, etc. must have all pieces and not be out of date.
- Tie or tape shoes together - DO NOT place shoes in Ziploc bags!
- Group small items (such as socks or sippy cups) in a large Ziploc bag, tape it shut and tag the bag.
- All items that require batteries must have them in working condition.
- Other cloth items such as baby slings should be washed, folded, and placed in a Ziploc bag.

WHAT SHOULD I CHARGE?

- We recommend pricing at about 30% of retail. Higher-priced items should also be marked with the original retail price.
